### Respect Democracy and Human Rights! Stand with Myanmar people!

**Context:**

On February 1, 2021, the Myanmar military coup took over the democratically elected government and detained the leader of National League for Democracy (NLD) Aung San Suu Kyi and other officers. The leaders of the military coup have claimed the election in November 2020 was fake and announced a state of emergency, which most recently was extended to August 2023. Since then, nation-wide protests known as the Civil Disobedience Movement (CDM) took place and have now turned to civil war in Myanmar. Many young people are on the street to fight against the military coup, but the violence response on behalf of the military coup is causing many people to die.

**Impact on youth and students:**

A clear and strong determination within the young generation for democracy and human rights. Hopelessness and helplessness among young people in Myanmar after fighting against the military coup for one and half years without seeing any changes.

**Proposed Resolution:**

- 1- Condemn the human rights violations carried out by the military coup since the military seized power in 2021.
- 2- Continue monitoring the situation in Myanmar under the military government, especially the future of young people.



3- Call for solidarity from WSCF and SCMs, through standing with the people of Myanmar by regular prayers, listening to their live testimony, and bringing hope and comfort to them from the wider ecumenical community.
