Esteemed WSCF family,

Brothers and sisters,

Greetings from the Interregional office of the World Student Christian Federation,

I hope this message finds you and your movements safe and healthy. As we announced in our first Memo, our 37th General Assembly (GA) will take place in Berlin from June 23 to July 1, 2022. This decision was taken by the WSCF Executive Committee (ExCo) in November 2021.

The purpose of this second official communication is to inform you that, due to the current context of constant changes of the sanitarian measures taken by governments, **we have extended the deadline for voting members (Delegates from Affiliated SCMs, ExCO members and Officers) and CF Board of Trustees Members, to register by February 6 at the latest.**

Each affiliated SCM should select his or her delegate to attend the GA (just one delegate per movement). To follow the process started in the last Extraordinary Virtual General Assembly 2021, many SCMs send the same delegate that participated in the V-GA, but remember that this is not a rule. Each SCM should take its final decision internally and democratically. The WSCF Interregional Office will take care of the gender and student balances and may request an affiliated SCM to change to rebalance the list of delegates.



As you all know, we are living hectic times with restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemic, which has increased our work in logistics. For that reason, we will review constantly to reassess the situation based on the contingency measures decided by the ExCo: to have as much participation as possible, considering the possibility of a hybrid assembly of 80% in-person delegates and 20% delegates through virtual participation. If the number of delegates participating in virtual modality is more than 30%, the General Assembly will be postponed.

This assessment will mainly take into account the latest entry sanitary regulations in Germany regarding VISAS applications and rules concerning group meetings in closed spaces. As a result of this assessment, participants who will not be authorized to attend the “in-person” General Assembly will still be able to participate “online” through a virtual platform.

**The first assessment will be ready for February 15.** We will get, at that time, a first estimate of the number of participants who will probably attend the GA. Then, WSCF Interregional Office and ESG will continuously monitor the situation at the local level in Berlin and follow up health conditions in each country, with the objective to have a full participation of all SCM delegates. WSCF understands that the health situation and vaccines approvals may change in the coming months.

**On May 15th, we plan to have the final data to take a final decision** based on the percentage of possible participants. If 70% of voting members cannot, at least, attend the GA, the ExCo will have to decide about a possible postponement of the event.

A crucial point that will guide decisions will be vaccines regulations in force at that time applicable to visitors from High-Risk areas as defined by the German Government. Today, vaccines authorised by the Federal Ministry of Health of Germany (Bundesministerium für Gesundheit, BMG), are:

- Comirnaty - BioNTech, Pfizer
- Spikevax (COVID-19 Vaccine Moderna)
- COVID-19 Vaccine Janssen
- Vaxzevria - COVID-19 Vaccine AstraZeneca
- Nuvaxovid (NVX-CoV2373), Novavax

Together with the Regional Secretaries, after the final assessment, we will contact each delegate and follow up with them on their VISA application.

We look forward to your presence, your prayers and your support for the success of this Assembly.
