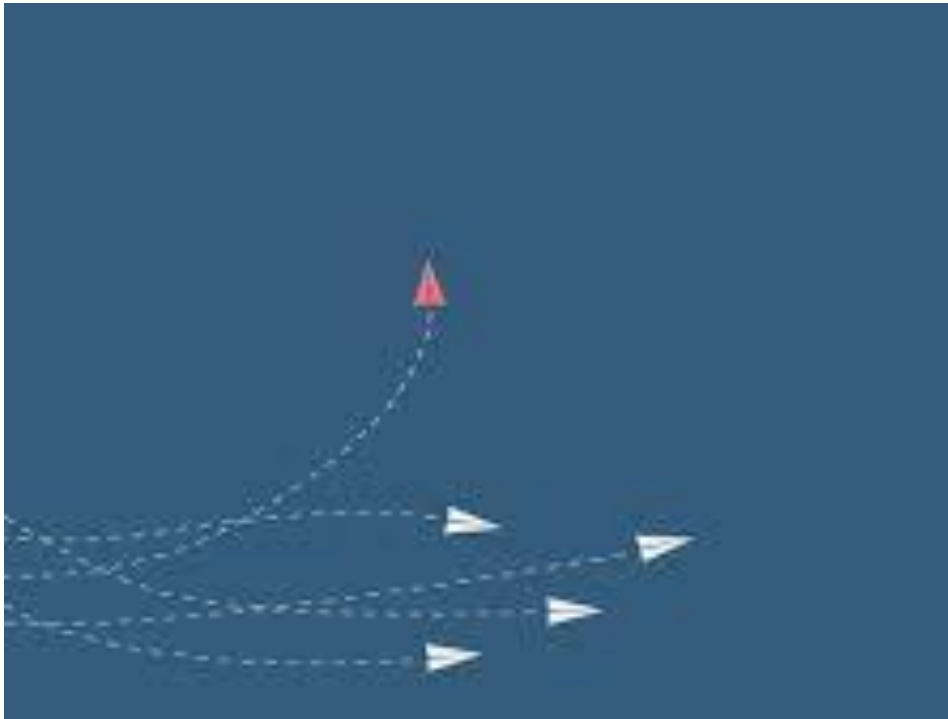

STEP 1

The Journey of an amendment begins with a national movement spotting something in the Constitution or the by-laws they would like to change.

STEP 2

When the national movement has decided exactly how they would like their amendment to be worded, It is desirable that they confer with their regional executive committee members to make sure everyone is clued in.

STEP 3

Then the national movement should communicate their proposed amendment to the IRO, who liaises with the Constitutional Commission.

STEP 4

The amendment should be communicated at least eight months before the General Assembly. This is to allow the IRO to inform the national movements of the desired amendment within the constitutionally required six months.

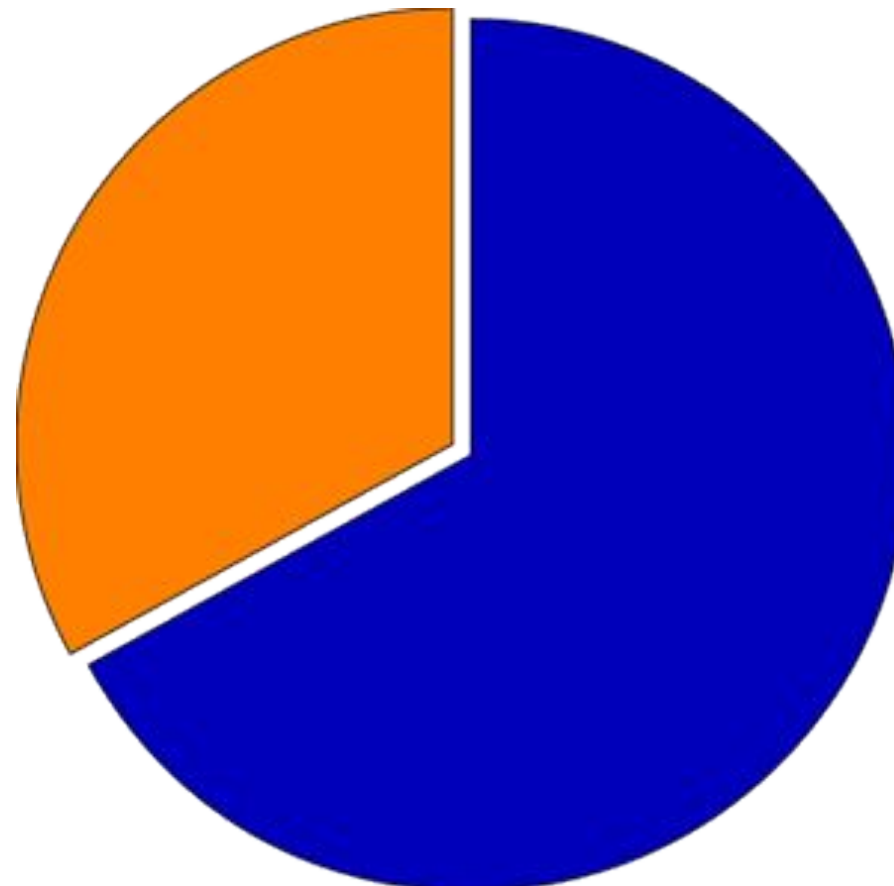
STEP 5

The Constitutional Commission Works with the national movements to ensure that their exact meaning and the best wording is communicated on the General Assembly floor.



STEP 7

To bring change to the constitution, or the by-law, requires a two-thirds majority of the members present on the floor of the general assembly.

STEP 8

The proposed change takes immediate effect, and the written form of the Constitution should be adapted as soon as possible. The constitution, with changes, should be disseminated in the official languages of the WSCF.
